Google Search Tip

The way Google search works is to take what you search for and match it with keywords in online content.

When you search for too many words, it may limit your results. That means it may actually take you longer to find what you're looking for. Thus, it is apropos to use only the important words when searching for something. Let's see an example:

- Don't use: Where can I find a Chinese restaurant that delivers.
- Instead try: Chinese restaurants nearby.
- Or: Chinese restaurants near me.

Doing this can help Google find what you need without all the clutter. So keep it simple and only use important words. (lifehack.org)

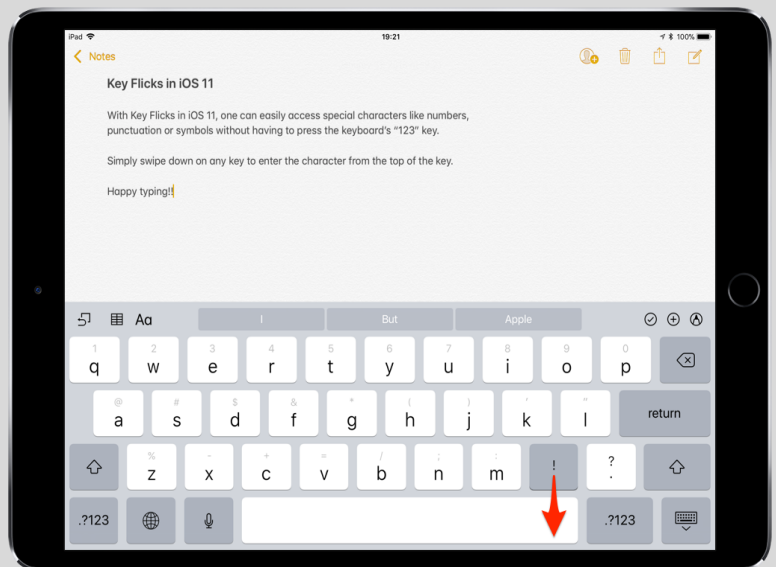

Type Faster with Key Flicks

Go to Settings → General → Keyboard and slide the switch labeled Enable Key Flicks to the ON position. Now when you use Apple’s QuickType keyboard, just flick down on letter keys to enter numbers, symbols and punctuation marks on your iPad. (downloadblog.com)
